“A Dispensation is a distinguishable economy in the outworking of God’s purpose” *Charles Ryrie*

“A Dispensation is a particular way of God’s administering His rule over the world as He progressively works out His purpose for world history” *Renald Showers*

2. The 3 Distinguishing Principles/Marks of Dispensationalism

a. A Literal Interpretation of the Scriptures whenever possible and a reliance on the “**Literal, Historical, Grammatical**” method of Hermeneutics.

“When the plain sense of Scripture makes common sense, seek no other sense, therefore, take every word at its primary, ordinary, usual, literal meaning unless the facts of the immediate context, studied in the light of related passages and axiomatic and fundamental truths, indicate clearly otherwise.”

“**The Golden Rule of Interpretation**” by *Dr. David L. Cooper*

b. A Clear and Consistent Distinction between Israel and ‘The Church’ and a recognition of the irrevocable, unconditional nature of the Abrahamic Covenant.

c. The Purpose/Theme of History is “The Glory of God”

**B. Progressive Revelation**

“God’s message to man was not given in one single act, but was unfolded in a long series of successive acts through the hands of many men of varying backgrounds.”

“A system of theology based upon the two covenants of Works and Grace as governing categories for the understanding of the entire Bible.”

**D. Ultra-Dispensationalism**

“The school of interpretation which places more than one Dispensation between Pentecost and the end of the Church age.”

### 1. **Fallacy:** *Dispensationalism was first invented by J.N. Darby in the 1860's.*

**2. Fallacy:** *Dispensationalism teaches that the 'Gifts' of the Holy Spirit have ceased.*
